



# PHEASANT VINEYARD

## 2003 Vintage

The 2003 growing season in the Napa Valley was long and even. There were few heat spikes during the summer months. Excellent growing conditions in the spring, and moderate even temperatures during summer and ripening make for intensely flavored and balanced wines. Early September was clear minus high heat. Harvest in mid October was clear with a cool morning, and warm afternoon.
